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INTRODUCTION TO PROVIDENCE UNIVERSITY



In the beginning of the twentieth century, having realized the call for their service in China which was then at war and in poverty, Mother Marie Gratia Luking (1885-1964) and five sisters from the American Sisters of Providence sailed from the United States to China to begin their tough work with only their faith and typewriters.

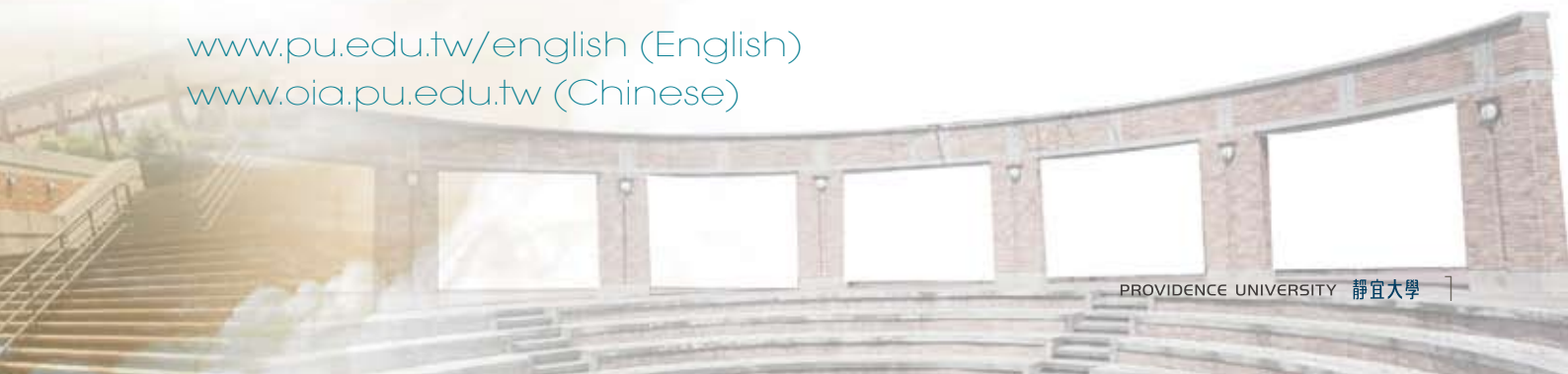
In 1920, Mother Luking arrived in China for the first time and began her preaching and education career. In 1948, she went to Taiwan and established the Catholic English Supplementary School in the following year. In 1956, Providence Junior College for Women was officially established as the forerunner of the Providence University. In 1963, Providence Junior College for Women was promoted to become the Providence College of Arts and Sciences for Women for its excellent performance in running the school. It was the only women's college in Taiwan, and also the first evening college in central Taiwan. In 1987 autumn,

Providence University was moved to the present address in Shalu Town, Taichung County. In 1989, it was promoted to the Providence Girl's University. In 1993, it was renamed as Providence University and began to recruit male students.

The university was named Providence to commemorate the Sisters of Providence to which the founding sisters belonged; and its Chinese name Ching-yi is named after the Chinese name of Mother Luking.

The University is comprised of five colleges: 1.) Foreign Languages and Literature, 2.) Humanities and Social Sciences, 3.) Sciences, 4.) Management; 5.) Computing and Informatics. Within the colleges there are twenty-two departments, nineteen graduate programs, two Ph.D. programs, and four EMBA programs. In addition, Providence has five centers: Chinese Language Education, Teacher Education, Humanities Education, Service Learning and Foreign Language.

3. All applicants must submit two official transcripts, either in English or in Chinese.
4. A notarized photocopy of a high school diploma from an applicant seeking admission as an undergraduate student or a notarized copy of a college diploma for seeking admission as a graduate student. (An official document, on school stationary, attesting to the applicant's forthcoming graduation will be accepted if the applicant has not yet graduated).
5. Two letters of recommendation which address the applicant's academic potential, participation in extracurricular activities, personal character, level of English and Chinese proficiencies and a comment regarding whether or not the applicant is mature enough to study abroad
6. Study Plan
(either in Chinese or English)
7. Proof that the applicant has the financial resources to support his/her living expenses, books and other school related fees
8. An International Student Scholarship Application Form
9. A photocopy of the applicant's passport or other equivalent supporting documents
10. Three passport-sized photographs
11. A foreign national citizen who was formerly a

citizen of the Republic of China must attach a certificate indicating that he/she is no longer a legal citizen of the Republic of China

12. Those who wish to pursue doctoral degrees must submit your research plan and a photocopy of the equivalent thesis including a Chinese or English abstract

Note:

1. Documents mentioned above in 3 and 4 must be notarized by the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office or an embassy of the representative of the Republic of China, Taiwan, in your area. Please find the list of Embassies Abroad at following link www.mofa.gov.tw)
2. Some departments offer courses in English but most undergraduate and graduate programs are mainly conducted in Mandarin Chinese. It is recommended that applicants are proficient in Chinese language skills.
3. Other documents may be required by certain departments or graduate institutes; in this case, the applicant will be informed. Providence University reserves the right to cancel/withhold a scholarship for reasons of student misconduct and/or if it suspects that a student has not registered for academic reasons.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Undergraduate international students, who have been granted admission to Providence University to study full-time for credit are automatically eligible for a scholarship to cover the cost of tuition during their first year.

In addition, they may continue to receive a tuition scholarship each consecutive semester, for up to four years, if they maintain an overall grade average of 75 or above. Full time international graduate students who have been accepted may also receive a tuition scholarship during their first year and again during their second year, on a semester basis, if they consistently earn an average of 80 or higher.

Providence University reserves the right to cancel/withhold a scholarship for reasons of student misconduct and /or if it suspects that a student has not registered for academic reasons. The scholarship plan does not apply to special summer programs.

Remarks:

1. Students who are confirmed to receive Taiwan Scholarship are unable to receive the PU Scholarship. However, Taiwan Scholarship recipients should submit the certificate provided by MOFA or MOE for reference.
